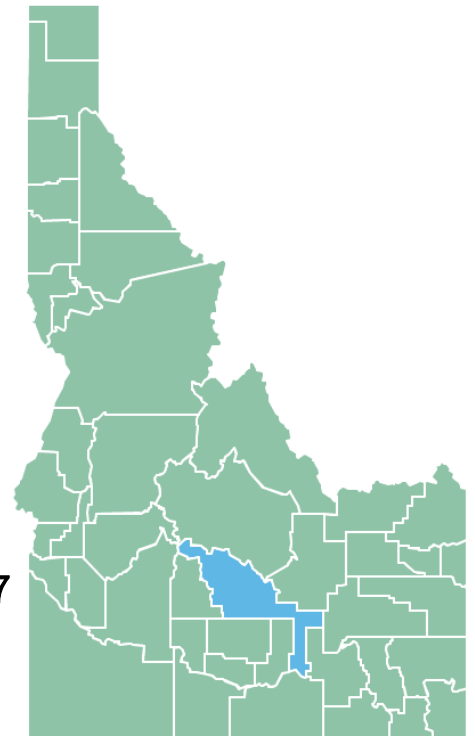

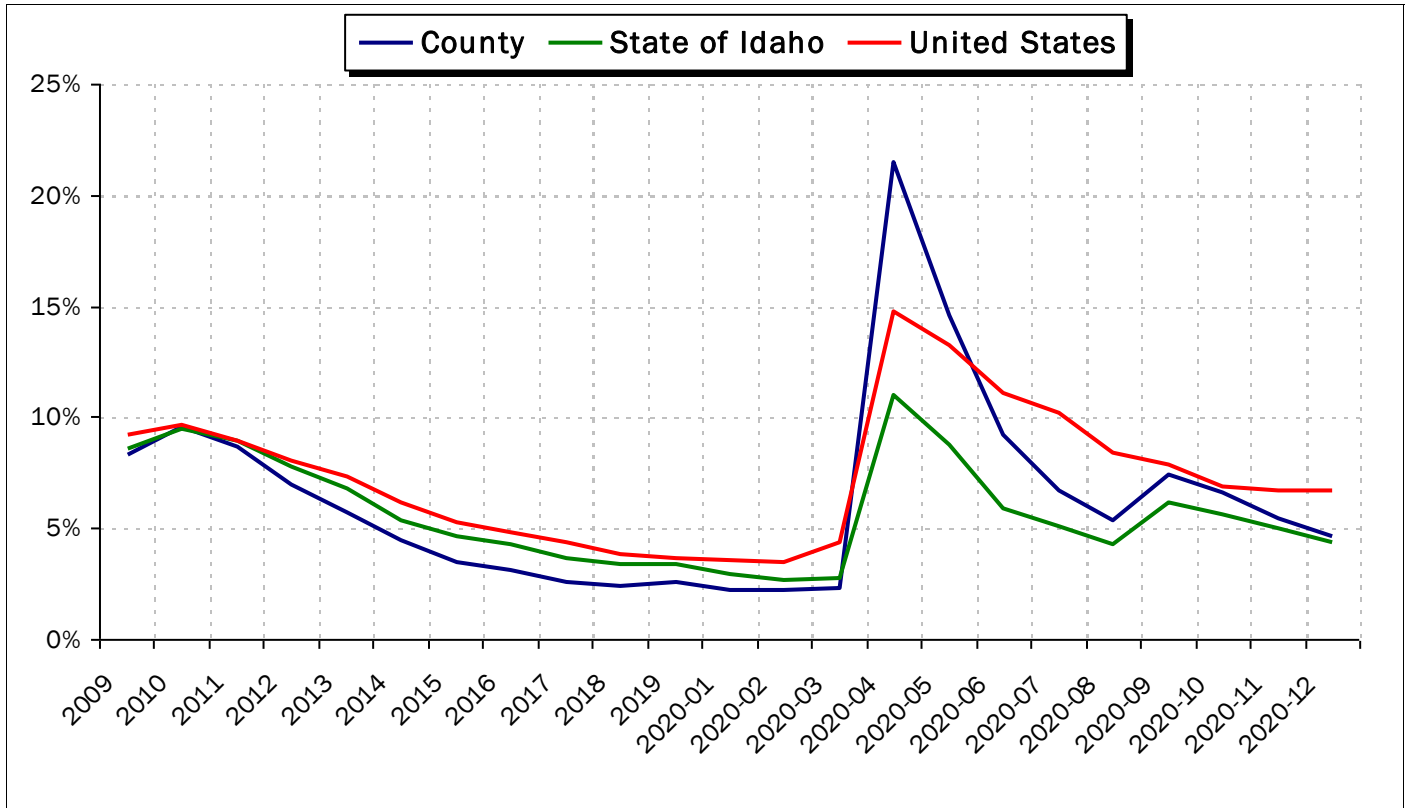

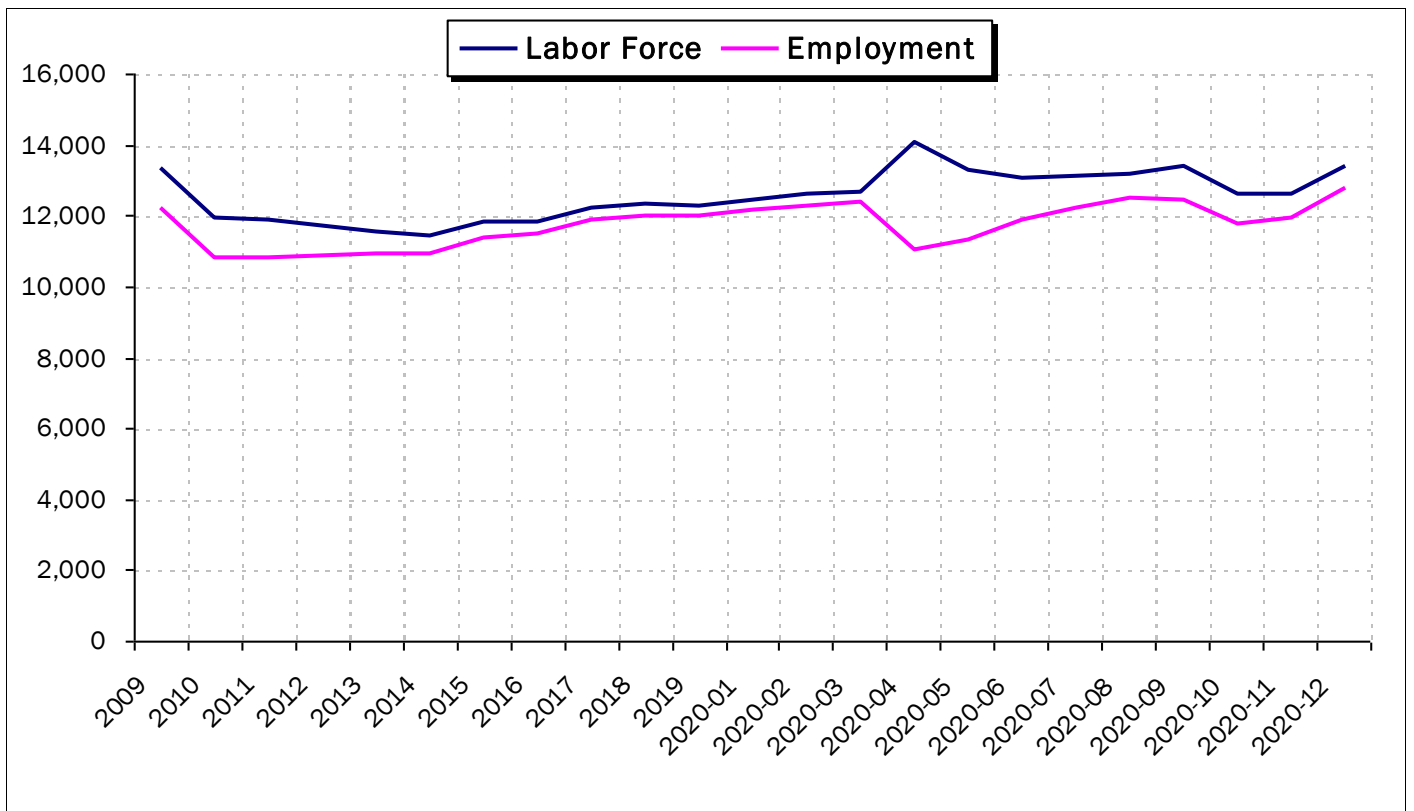

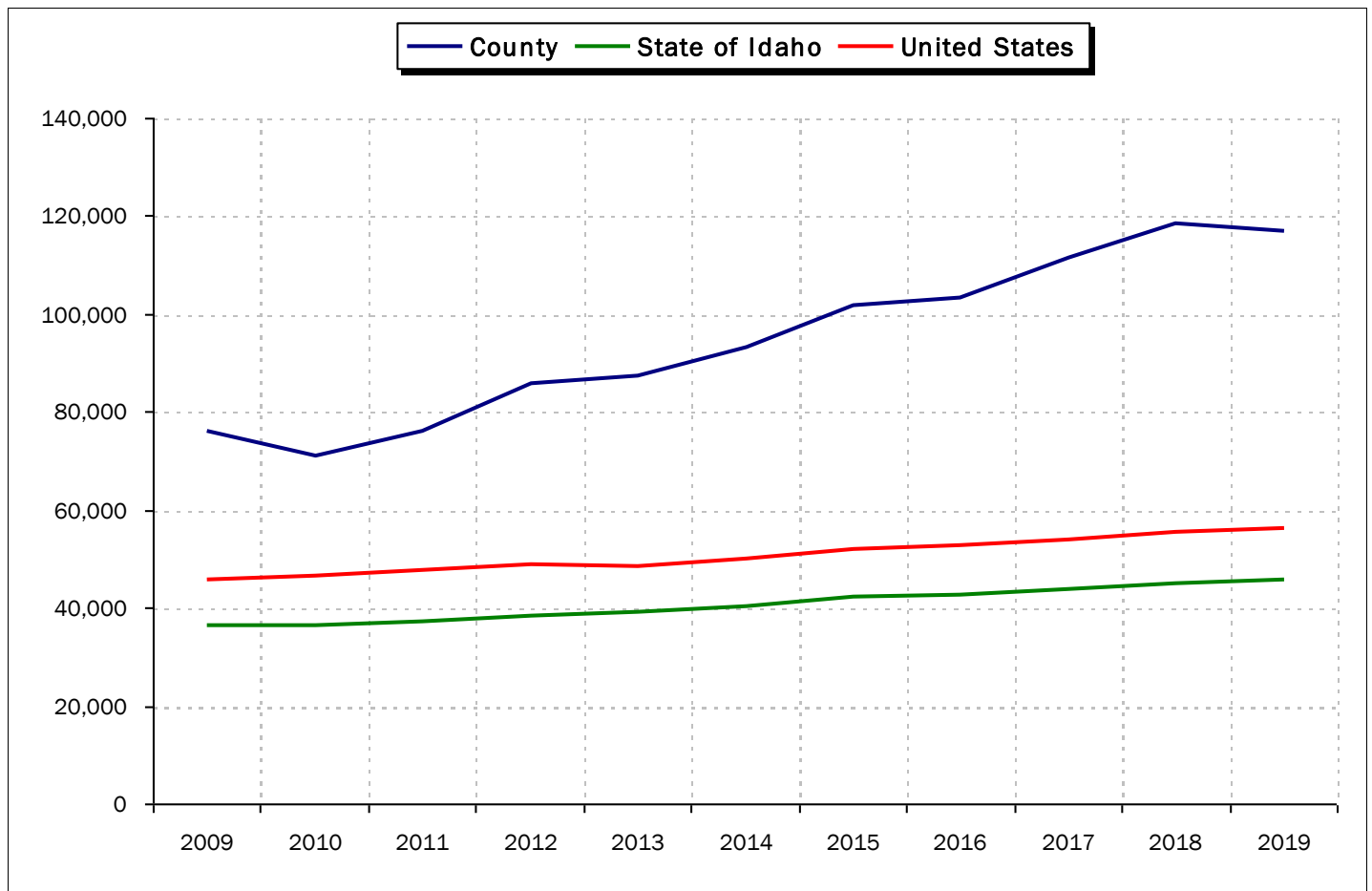

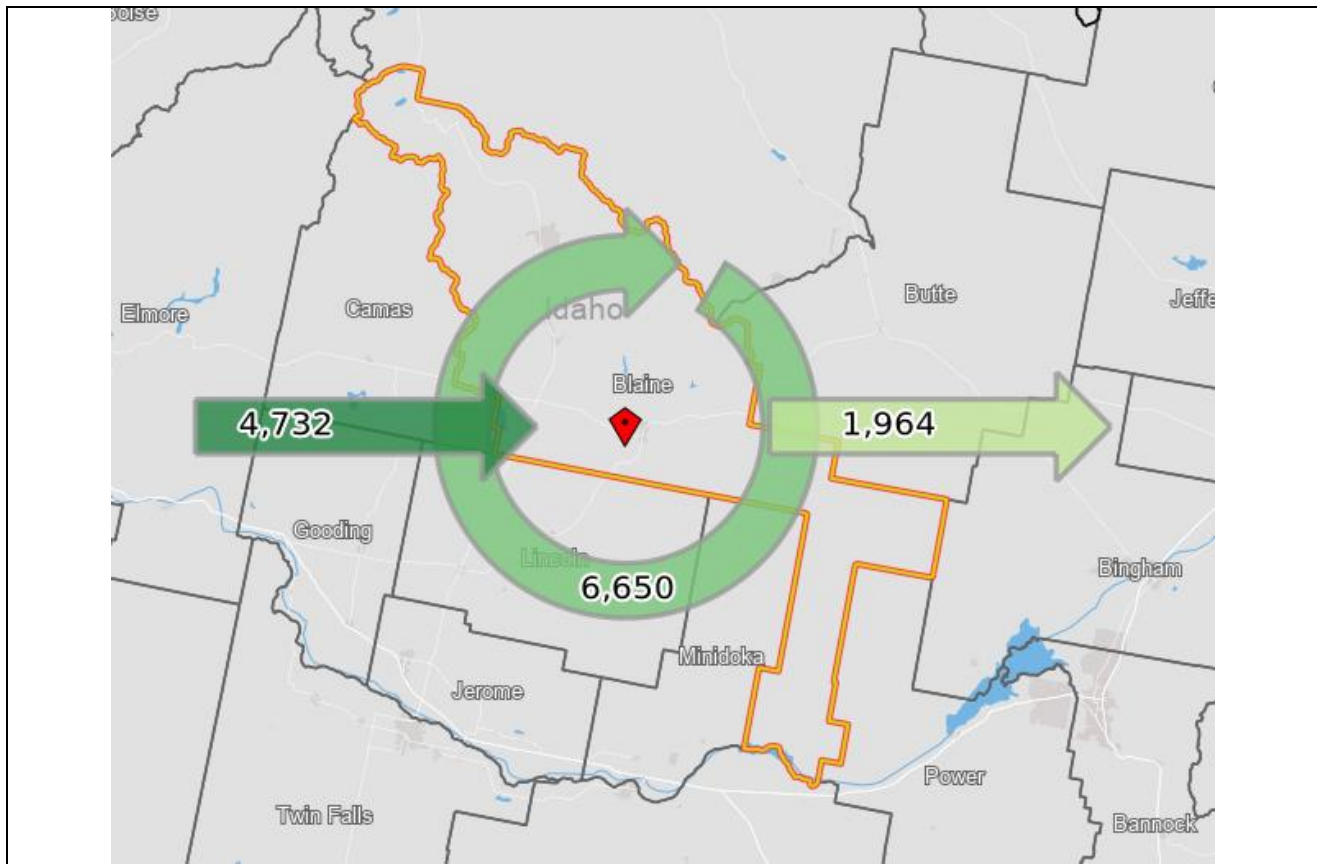
7. Real Per Capita Income, 2009 - 2019
